

Domestic Bliss Bathroom Checklist

- Cobweb the room entirely
- Put on your PPE, mask gloves and glasses
- If there's a blind in the room brush down with your dustpan brush and wipe your windowsill
- Spray DESCALE inside your shower stall covering all surfaces
- Descale around your bathroom taps bath taps and vanity taps
- Using a pool scrubber cover your mirrors and your outside of your shower screens with hot soapy water and then squeegee off left to right in a horizontal direction wait for your lines to dry
- using the pool scrubber and JIF scrub out your bath and any tile surrounds then
- clean your vanity including the splash-back & tile
- clean the bench itself, the sink, the front of the sink and front and lip of the cabinets
- Return your shower stall and give the shower a good rinse either with the shower hose or with your plastic cup and a bucket full of water then with JIF or chlorfoam on your pool scrubber give the entire interior shower screen scrub including floor
- if there are any scale buildup in the sides and door of the shower screen - use a scraper lightly where required, then squeegee off
- Buff dry all chrome , glass and the shower floor

Toilet checklist

- Cobweb the room and tile tops
- wipe the windowsills & brush down any blinds
- wipe over your light switches
- wipe over your toilet tissue holder & wipe over any bins
- wipe over (or place inside the toilet) the toilet brush and toilet brush holder and flush the toilet to rinse
- and then at the back of the toilet
- wipe all of the hoses, the metal taps and all of the parts under the toilet
- then starting from the top using JIF scrub your toilet top. the cistern .where the cistern meets the toilet seat. Undo toilet seat slightly so that you can get between the toilet seat and the toilet base
- scrub the front, top, all of the seats and the outside pedestal, and then bleach inside your toilet - give it a good spray, let it sit for a moment flush it and then scrub with a brush and rinse
- buff dry your toilet especially the seat so it's not wet
- don't forget to COVID Clean doorhandles and hot touch points
